Every good Catholic participates in the Mass every Sunday. But how well do we know what we are doing?

Lifelong Catholics Father Vincent Hawkswell, a retired priest of the Archdiocese of Vancouver, who teaches Homiletics at the Seminary of Christ the King in Mission BC, and Maureen Creelman, a retired physics and mathematics teacher, who teaches Math 12 at the same Seminary, will speak on what they understand of the Mass.

In the first session -- on the Thursday evening -- they will examine the prefigurations of the Mass in the Jewish liturgy.

- In the second session -- on the Friday evening -- they will look in detail at the events of Holy Week, when Jesus celebrated the first Mass.
- In the third session -- early on the Saturday morning -- they will speak about the Mass as the Church celebrates it today

In the fourth session -- after Mass on Saturday morning -- they will talk about the Catholic priesthood and the ritual of the Mass today. Anyone is welcome to drop in for any or all of the sessions.
